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### Associate Principal Investigator Scheme

MYTH

VS

FACT

"The Associate PI Scheme is only for Trainees and Doctors"



The Associate PI Scheme is for any Healthcare professional who isn't already funded to work on research.

"I can start working on a study now and register for the Associate PI Scheme later"



You must register for the Associate PI Scheme prior to starting working on your chosen study.

"I am an official Associate PI now I have received confirmation of my registration"



You are not officially recognised as an Associate PI until you have completed the Scheme and received your certificate.

"I can take part in the scheme for 4 months and submit my checklist early."



You must complete your full 6 month tenure on the Associate PI Scheme before you submit your checklist.

"I cannot continue on the Associate PI Scheme if I move to another site"



As long as the study is taking place at your new site, you can continue your tenure on the Associate PI Scheme at your new site.  
\*Subject to approval

"My hospital will receive backfill funding so that I can take part in the Associate PI Scheme"



There is no funding associated with the Associate PI Scheme. Applicants take part in the scheme alongside their core day to day role.
